In witness whereof the said William Cault and John H. Cault have hereunto subscribed their names and affixed their seals this sixth day of July in the year Eighteen hundred and forty one.

But is remembered that on the sixth day of July in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and forty one before the subscriber a Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland in and for the County aforesaid personally appeared William Cault and John H. Cault the parties to the within and foregoing instrument of writing and acknowledged the same to be their act and deed according to the intent true intent and meaning thereof and of the acts of assembly in such case made and provided.

Cault the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge and am therewith fully satisfied have bargained sold delivered and by these presents do bargain sell and deliver unto the said John H. Cault his executors administrators and assigns all and singular the following goods and chattels to wit: the entire stock consisting of Horses Cattle Sheep and Hogs and all the farming utensils now on the farm called Mulberry Point on which the said John H. Cault now resides, also one horse Colt three years old now on the farm in Island Creek Neck whereon Joseph Cault resides; To Have and To Hold the said goods and chattels unto the said
