 sixth day of July in the year
 William Cauck Sr. of our Lord one thousand and eight
 hundred and forty one the following Bill of Sale or Instru-
 ment of writing was received to be recorded and was accord-
 ingly enrolled as follows to wit: Whereas William Cauck
 of Talbot County in the State of Maryland has by Deed
 of Manumission bearing equal date with these presents
 duly executed acknowledged and recorded according to
 law liberated and set free among others the following ne-
 groes to wit: a negro man named Ashby Ridout a
 negro boy named Jack Ridout a negro woman named
 Harriett Ridout a negro girl named Ann Ridout a
 negro man named Tom Thomas a negro woman named
 Jane Thomas and a negro girl named Catherine Thom-
 as to take effect upon their arrival respectively to the
 ages of thirty one years reserving to himself in the mean
 time the use and services of the said negroes: and has
 also in the said Deed fixed and determined the State
 and condition of the issue which may be born of the
 female negroes in the said Deed mentioned on or be-
 fore their arrival respectively to the ages of thirty one
