Now know all men by these presents that the said William Caule for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars current money to him in hand paid by William Caule Sr. who is now and for more than one year last past has been a bona fide resident of the State of Maryland the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath bargained sold assigned and transferred and by these presents doth bargain sell assign and transfer unto the said William Caule Sr. his executors administrators and assigns all his the said William Caule's right and interest in and to the said negroes for and during the period and term of servitude by him reserved as aforesaid: that is to say from the date hereof until the said negroes shall respectively attain the ages of thirty and years and also in and to the issue to be born of the female negroes above named during the period or term of their servitude as aforesaid for and during the period or term as fixed and determined by him as mentioned and stated in the said above recited Decree of Manumission; To Have and To Hold all the right and interest of him the said William Caule in and to the said negroes for and during the aforesaid terms of servitude so by him reserved and hereby bargained and sold to the said William Caule Sr. his executors administrators and assigns together with all and every of the issue which the above named female negroes may have in or before the expiration of their respective terms of servitude for and during the periods or terms during which the State and condition of the said issue is fixed to be slavery or servitude as mentioned and expressed in the Decree of Manumission herein before referred to. In witness whereof the said William Caule and William Caule Sr. have hereunto subscribed their names and affixed their seals this second day of July in the year Eighteen hundred and forty one.
