Green being of the age of three months to take effect from and after his arrival at the age of thirty one years; also my negro girl named July Ann Green being of the age of nine years to take effect from and after her arrival at the age of thirty one years; also my negro boy named Frank Joshua being of the age of five years to take effect from and after his arrival at the age of thirty one years; also my negro woman named Sila Green being of the age of twenty nine years to take effect from and after her arrival at the age of thirty one years; also my negro boy named George Green being of the age of seven years to take effect from and after his arrival at the age of thirty one years; also my negro boy named James Green being of the age of five years to take effect from and after his arrival at the age of thirty one years; also my negro girl named Eliza Green being of the age of three years to take effect from and after her arrival at the age of thirty one years; also my negro girl named Ellen Green being of the age of one year to take effect from and after her arrival at the age of thirty one years; also my negro man Hiram Sharp being of the age of twenty three years to take effect from and after his arrival at the age of thirty one years; also my negro girl named Matilda Green being of the age of six months to take effect from and after her arrival at the age of thirty one years; and I do hereby declare that the future offspring and issue of the female negroes above mentioned shall be free as they respectively attain the age of thirty one years reserving to myself the use and service of the said above named negroes and the future offspring and issue of the said female negroes until their arrival respectively to the age of thirty one years as aforesaid from and after which I hereby declare them and each of them free manumitted and discharged from all manner of servitude or service to me, my executors administrators and assigns forever.
