Instrument of writing was received to be recorded and was accordingly enrolled as follows, to wit: Know all men by these Presents, That I William Edmondson of Talbot County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and ninety dollars current money of Maryland to me in hand paid by John Edmondson of Talbot County & State of Maryland the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, and am therewith fully satisfied, have bargained, sold, and by these Presents do bargain & sell unto the said John Edmondson his executors, administrators and assigns One wood mantle clock, three beds, beds and furniture, 1 sideboard, one Bureau, one pair Mahogany end Tables, one and an half dozen chairs, one water stand, an half dozen pictures, one English Carpet, two domestic Carpets, one gilt frame looking glass & one Mahogany framed looking glass, one small dressing glass, 4 pine Tables, one wash stand, bowl & pitcher, one writing desk, one stove, one tea board & three small waiters, four trunks - one Silver Ladle, one half dozen silver spoons, one half dozen silver Teaspoons, one dozen China Coffee cups & saucers - one black tin coffee pot, two and an half dozen Plates, one knife box and one dozen knives & forks, one set brass and bronze one iron do. & iron pots, 1 Tea Kettle, 1 oven, 1 safe, 1 set Tongs & shovel, one hot washing tubs, 300 weight Bacon, 30 lb. Lard, 1 barrel flour, 1 hot Tin ware, hot glass Tumbler &c. one pair sad Irons, 1 hot Table Linen & Towelling.

To Have and To Hold the said described property unto the said John Edmondson his executors, administrators and assigns, to the only proper use and behoof of the said John Edmondson his executors, administrators and assigns forever. And I the said William Edmondson for my executors and administrators, the said bargained property unto the said John Edmondson his executors, administrators and assigns, against all persons shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents.
