Hall of Talbot County State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred dollar to me in hand paid by William B. Willis of the County and State aforesaid at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said William B. Willis his Executors, Administrators and assigns, a negro boy named David slave for ever supposed to be about nine years old. To have and to hold the said negro slave named David above bargained and sold, or intended to be to the said William B. Willis, his Executors, Administrators and assigns forever. - And I the said John H. Hall for myself my heirs, Executors and Administrators the said negro boy, with the name David, as a slave unto the said William B. Willis, his Executors and Administrators against me the said John H. Hall my Executors and Administrators and against all and every other person and persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defende by these presents. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal in the presence of, this 4th day of August 1830.
