 forever. And we the said Heilemon Willis and Susan Ellen Willis, for our-
 selves, our heirs, Executors and Administrators, the said, negro Boy slave
 named David, as a slave unto the said, William B. Willis, his Executors,
 and Administrators, against us the said Heilemon Willis and Susan
 Ellen Willis our Executors and Administrators and against all and every
 other person and persons whatsoever, shall and will, warrant and forever
