In the name of God amen I Ferringham Drury of Anne Arundel
 County being weak in body but of a sound disposing mind memory
 and understanding do make and publish this my last will and
 Testament in manner and form following and after my just debts are
 paid I devise and bequeath as follows viz I give and bequeath
 unto my son Abel H Drury part of the land wherean I now live
 called Birchheads parcel and Birchheads meadow included in the
 following metes and bounds beginning at the westernmost corner of my
 son Abels Land and running with the land formerly occupied by
 Richard Darnall north thirty one degrees East thirty four perches
 then East twenty seven perches to a white Oak then north Sixty
 one degrees East twelve perches then South Seventy Seven degrees East
 ninety four perches to a black heart cherry tree standing in the Cherry
 walk then south Sixty Six degrees East one hundred and four
 perches to the easternmost line of my said land then with the land of
 my son Abels to the first beginning containing forty five acres more
 or less to him and his heirs forever - I give and bequeath
 unto my three daughters Susanna Mary and Ann Mariah Drury
 all the remaining part of my land wherean I now live which is not
 devised to my son Abel to be sold for their use and divided equally
 amongst them by my Executor after the youngest of them shall
 arrive to the age of sixteen years - I give and bequeath unto
 my son Richard Drury one hundred and forty three acres of land
 called Harrison security which I bought of Mr Dering Estate to him
 and his heirs forever provided he will pay the sum of three hundred Dollars
 to my grandson Ferringham Childs when he arrives to the age of twenty
 one years without interest - I give and bequeath to my daughter
 Sophia Childs three hundred Dollars and a negro girl named Matilda
 I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Eliza five hundred
 dollars to be put on Interest well secured by bond and security under
 the direction of the cyphars Court and the interest to be paid annually
 for her support during her minority and in case she should die
 before she arrives to the age of sixteen years then the five hundred dollars
 shall be equally divided between the rest of my daughters then living -
 I give and bequeath unto my son Richard Drury the Chickesaw
 horse and my surveying instruments provide he will improve in

surveying a Term I give and bequeath unto my four Daughters
 Susanna Mary Ann Maria and Eliza all the residue of my Estate
 and my will is that my wife Sarah Drury shall have the use of the
 residue of my Estate so devised and the profits arising therefrom and
 also the use of the land devised my three daughters and the profits
 thereof for their maintenance and support untill the youngest arrives
 to the age of Sixteen years and in case either should die before the
 age of Sixteen then the survivors shall possess the same and my will
 is that my wife Sarah Drury shall be entitled to her dower in all
 the land I have devised my children and also to her dower in
 my personal Estate - and lastly I do hereby appoint my wife
 Sarah Drury Executrix to this my last will and Testament revoking
 all former wills and Testaments by me heretofore made ratifying
 and confirming this and none other to be my last will and
 Testament - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
 seal this Eighteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one
 thousand Eight hundred and twenty five -
