


Maryland &c To all whom these presents shall come I Jermingham Drury of Ann Arundel County for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving declare free Manumit Liberate and enfranchise the following Negroes. To wit. in a former Manumission Negro Sarah I declared to be free on the first day of March Eighteen hundred and twenty seven. She is now about Eighteen years of age. I now declare her to be free on the first day of January Eighteen hundred and twenty three and her children to the latest generation to be free as follows. males at the age of twenty five years. and females at the age of twenty one, Richard about two years of age to be free on the first day of January Eighteen hundred and forty three. Thomas aged about three months to be free on the first day of January Eighteen hundred and forty five, hereby acknowledging the said Negroes discharged from all claim of service and right of property whatever from me my heirs Executors, and Administrators in the manner and form above mentioned viz Sarah to be free on the 1st day January 1823. and her increase to be free males at the age of twenty five years. and females at the age of twenty one years to the latest generation, Richard to be free on the 1st January 1813.. Thomas to be free on 1st January = 1845. As witness my hand and seal this seventh. of January One thousand Eight hundred and twenty
