

Copy of deed to R. Murphy per line filed 12th April 1864

At the request of Elizabeth Boyd the following Deed was recorded the 25th day of November 1863. This Deed made this nineteenth day of November in the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty three by us William C. Fowler, Alice S. Fowler his wife and Martha K. Jones of Montgomery County in the state of Maryland. Whereas by a decree of the Circuit Court for Montgomery County as a Court of Equity, dated the sixteenth day of April in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty nine in the said then pending in which William C. Fowler and wife et al. were Complainants and Mary P. Jones et al. defendants, Richard J. Bowie was appointed trustee to sell certain lands lying and being in said County and therein referred to and afterwards in pursuance of said decree, did sell a part of said lands to Leah Jones now deceased, and duly reported the same which was finally ratified and confirmed. And whereas on petition of William C. Fowler, Alice S. Fowler his wife and Martha K. Jones, the said trustee was by order of said Court, passed on the thirteenth day of November in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty
