At the request of Larkin Johnson the following deed was recorded June 3rd 1862, to wit: This deed made this second day of December in the year Eighteen Hundred and Fifty seven by Richard T. Bentley and Edith D Bentley his wife of Montgomery County in the state of Maryland, Witnesses, that in consideration of Eighty nine dollars and six and one quarter cents the said Richard T Bentley and Edith D Bentley his wife of said county and state doth grant unto Larkin Johnson of said county and state all that lot or parcel of ground situated in Montgomery County which is described as follows, Beginning for the same at a stone planted at the end of the first line of W^m John Thomas land and running thence South Eight and one half degrees East forty four perches to a stone on the outline of R. T. Bentley's land then with said outline North sixty one and Three quarter degrees West Twenty two perches to a stone it being the end of the first line of Henry Wrights Lot then with the second line of said lot north six degrees West Twenty three and one half perches to a stone on the second line of William John Thomas' land then with said line reversed North Fifty Eight degrees East Eighteen perches
