

# THE DRAFT IN MARYLAND.

## Fifth Congressional District.

[Correspondence of the Baltimore Sun.]

ELLICOTT'S MILLS, May 23, 1864.

The following is the result of the draft in this district to-day, the 4th and 5th election districts, of Howard, and the 1st district of Montgomery county being drawn. There are enrolled in 4th district of Howard co. 492, of which 40 were drawn. In the 5th district 437 were enrolled, and 36 drawn, and in the 1st district of Montgomery 610 were enrolled, and 63 drawn. The proportion of colored persons drawn is largely in excess of whites thus far. In Howard county, (now completed,) out of 181 drafted 76 are colored, which is in the proportion of nearly 2 to 1:
