In the name of God, Amen I John Griffin of Baltimore County in the State of Maryland, being Sick and weak in body but of sound and disposing mind

memory and understanding, considering the certainty of death, and the uncertainty of the time thereof, and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs and thereby be the better prepared to leave this World when it shall please God to call me hence do therefore make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say

First and principally I commit my Soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my body to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executrix herein after named and after my debts and funeral charges are paid. I devise and bequeath as follows: Item, I give and devise unto my Sister Rebecca A. Griffin, my plantation (or farm) whereon I now dwell known by the name of a part of Glynmalirica manor, containing by deed one hundred and four acres of land, more or less.

I will and bequeath unto my aforesaid Sister Rebecca A Griffin two Negroes (male) the one named Andrew Freeman aged about sixty years (black), the other (Pinlatto) named Pinlton Griffin to serve during their natural life, the last named negro aged about eighteen years.

Likewise I will and bequeath unto my said Sister Rebecca A Griffin the

All my horses, being three in number. also all my horned cattle cows and Oxen with the hogs I have.

I likewise will and bequeath all my household Furniture of every kind unto the aforesaid Sister Rebecca A Griffith with all my Farming utensils and tools. Wagons. Carts &c. and all Kitchen Furniture of every kind. with all the Corn Cabb and every kind of grain that is on the farm or growing thereon.

I also will and bequeath unto my said Sister Rebecca A Griffin all the money I have, and the notes of hand I have and every evidence of debt belonging to me of every kind.

Also I will and bequeath unto my said Sister Rebecca A Griffin, a Land Warrant I obtained for serving in the war between the United States and England the said Land warrant being now in my possession. and I hereby empower my said Sister to sell said Land warrant and make a right thereto. the same as I could were I alive and present.

And further I devise and bequeath unto my Sister Rebecca A Griffin the rest and residue of my Estate should there be any. as it is my express desire that she shall have all I am possessed with.

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my Sister Rebecca A. Griffin to be Sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament. Ratifying and Confirming this and more other to be my last Will and Testament.
