Martha Cannon Be it remembered that the following Deed was recorded on from the 6<sup>th</sup> day of March 1826 to wit - Joseph Johnson and Ebenezer Johnson This Indenture made on this first day of March in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and twenty six between Joseph Johnson and Ebenezer Johnson of Dorchester County and State of Maryland of the one part and Martha Cannon widow of Jesse Cannon dec<sup>d</sup> of Sussex County and State of Delaware of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Joseph Johnson and Ebenezer Johnson for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand Dollars current Money to them the said Joseph Johnson and Ebenezer Johnson in hand paid by the said Martha Cannon before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the said Joseph Johnson and Ebenezer Johnson doth hereby acknowledge and from every part and parcel thereof doth hereby acquit discharge the said Martha Cannon hath granted bargained sold delivered enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Martha Cannon her heirs and assigns all that tract or part of a tract or parcel of land Situate lying and being in Dorchester County State of Maryland called Willsons plain (beginning at a forked red hard Cherry tree standing on the south west side of the County road leading from Willsons Cross roads to N.W. Fork bridge being the north Westermont Cherry tree or the furthest in the rough a long the fence towards the N.W. Fork bridge then runs South forty minuts West Eighteen perches to the center of the County road leading from Cratchers ferry and then with said road south Eighty five degrees East fourteen perches to the Cross roads then with the road leading to N.W. Fork bridge north forty degrees west Eight perches and North thirty thirty degrees west Sixteen and seven tenths perches then south forty minuts West three quarters of a perch home containing one hundred and Sixteen square perches more or less with the appertinances thereto belonging with remain dec<sup>d</sup> rents and reverses of the aforesaid land and premises and every part thereof and all and singular the improvements belonging to said land unto her the said Martha Cannon her heirs and assigns forever forever to her sole and proper use and for no other use intent or purpose whatsoever and the aforesaid Joseph Johnson and Ebenezer Johnson for their Executors Administrators do hereby covenant and grant and agree to and with the said Martha Cannon her heirs and assigns forever will warrant and forever defend by these presents the land and premises herebefore mentioned in this Instrument of writing In Testimony whereof they the said Joseph Johnson and Ebenezer Johnson hath set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date within written - Joseph Johnson Eben Johnson

Be it remembered that on the first day of March 1826 personally appeared before us two of the Justices of the peace for said County Joseph Johnson and Ebenezer Johnson and did acknowledge the aforesaid deed and the land and premises therein mentioned to be the right title and Estate of the said Martha Cannon agreeable to the true intent and meaning of the aforesaid deed - Mr J Harper Ezekiel Wheatley
