raigned, tried, and convicted of having
persuaded, induced and assisted Negro man
Tom Camper, to escape and run away
from your petitioners, the said Negro
Tom Camper, being their slave.

Your petitioners further represent
that the said Samuel Mackay, was
on the twenty first day of December
in the year eighteen hundred and
fifty eight, sold by the Sheriff of Tal-
^{Scough}bot County, to the order of this
Court, and was purchased by William
H. Mabb attorney for the sum of nine
hundred and fifty five dollars, in
cash-

Your petitioners further represent
that they were compelled to pay as
a reward for the apprehension of
the said Tom Camper, the sum of
Two hundred dollars, current money.

Your petitioners therefore pray
your Honor to order and direct
the Sheriff of Talbot County, to pay to
them or their attorney, the said sum
