Queen Anne's County Court: Be it remembered that on this 23rd
day of August in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and sixty
eight the following deed of manumission was brought to be recorded
to wit:

Deed of manumission and Release of Service.
Whereas my slave John C. Anneya has entered in the Service of the United
States: now in consideration thereof, I, Mary S. Seligman of

Quinn Annis County State of Maryland, do hereby in consideration of said
enlistment manumitted and released the above named John C. Kinney
from all service due me, his freedom to commence from the 16th day of September
1863. the date of his enlistment as a private in the 7th Regiment of
Colored Troops in the service of the United States.
