These are to give Notice to all persons whom it may concern
 That I Walter Hoxton Commander of the Ship Battimore now riding at Anchor in
 Herring Bay in the County afo. Being purposed to Export Tobacco from Maryland
 to the Port of London in Great Britain on Freight this present Voyage I do hereby
 Publish the rate thereof at Seven pounds Sterling per Tonn (Provided a War is not
 Proclaimed in England before the departure of the said Ship out of this Province) the
 Freighters consigning their Tobacco's to M^r Samuel Hyde Merchant in London The said
 Ship usually carries about Nine Hundred Hogsheads of Tobacco But in Case of a War the
 said Walter Hoxton will take in no more then Seven Hundred, that she may be in a
 Sailing Trim, she is already well fitted for defence and man'd with thirty five Men
 which shall be augmented to fifty if to be procured in Maryland or Pennsylvania
 and in such Case the freight to be twelve pounds Sterling as Witness my hand this
 15th day of May 1734

 Richard Moore of An Arundel County in the Province of Maryland Merchant and
 Margaret my wife for divers good Causes us hereunto moving as well as the Consideration
 of one Shilling in hand paid Have given granted & by these presents do give grant
 & Confirm unto our well Beloved Sister Mary Moore of the same County & Province
 Spinster a certain Lot of Land lying and Situate in London Town Numbered fifty
 five & fronting on Small Street in the County and Province aforesaid To have and
 to hold all and singularly the appurtenances thereunto belonging to her and her
 heirs for ever freely peaceably & Quietly without any manner of Let Trouble or denial
 of us the said Richard & Margaret Moore or any Person or persons from us Claiming
 whatsoever of all which Premises we the said Richard & Margaret Moore have
 put the said Mary in full & Peaceable Possession by Virtue hereof In Witness whereof
 we have hereunto set our hands & Seals this first Day of January Anno Domini
 one thousand seven hundred and thirty three
