Marylandss KNOW all men by these presents that I Edward Savory of London Merchant have assigned ordained and made and in my stead and place put and Constituted my trusty and well beloved Friend Thomas Stockett Jun<sup>r</sup> of Annamudell County in the province of Maryland to be my true and Lawfull Att<sup>ny</sup> for me in my name &c. to my use to ask sue for Levey require recover and receive of all and Every pson and psons whatsoever all and Every such debts dues rents and Sums of Money Tob<sup>acco</sup> &c. as and now due unto me or which at any day or days time or times hereafter shall be due owing belonging or apper taining unto me by any Manner of way or means whatsoever Given and Grants unto my said Att<sup>ny</sup> by tenour of these presents my full and whole strength and Authority in and about the premises and upon the receipt of any such debts dues and Sums of money or Tobacco &c. a<sup>quittance</sup> or other Discharge for me and in my name to make Seal and Deliver, and all and Every other act and Acts thing and things device and Devices in the Law w<sup>h</sup>soever needfull and Necessary to be done in or about the premises for the recovery of any such debt dues rents & Sums as a<sup>foresaid</sup> for me, and in my name to doe Execute and perform as fully largely and simply in Every respect to all intents constructions and purposes, as I myself might or could do if I were personally present - Ratifying allowing and holding firm and stable all and w<sup>h</sup>soever my said Att<sup>ny</sup> shall Lawfully do or cause to be done in or about the Execution of the same by Vertue of these presents in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this sixteenth day of April Anno Domini 1718

of February on thousand seven hundred and Seventeen Between Abraham  
Means of Annarundell County planter of the one part and Josias Towgood  
of the said County Gent of the other part Witnesseth that the said  
Abraham Means for and in Consideration of the sum of Two thousand  
pounds of Tob<sup>o</sup>. to him in hand p<sup>d</sup>. by the said Josias Towgood attand  
before the Sealing & Delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said  
Abraham Means doth here by acknowledge and thereof Every part  
thereof doth acquitt the said Josias Towgood his heirs and assigns  
hath Given Granted bargained sold Alienated Enfeofed and Confirmed  
and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell Alienate Enfeoff &  
Confirm unto the said Josias Towgood his heirs assigns for Ever  
coming part of a part all that tract or parcell of Land being part of  
Grammers parrel beginning at a bounded Hickory by a branch being  
a bounded Tree of a parcell of Land sold by the said Abraham  
Means to Thomas Miles called addition being a part likewise of  
Grammers parrel on the East side of potaxen river and running  
with the said Land South East & by South fifty six p<sup>d</sup> to the Land  
formerly sold by Abraham Means to y<sup>e</sup>. s<sup>r</sup>. Thomas Miles called  
and running Northly to the s<sup>d</sup>. Land of Thomas Miles  
as the said Land runneth till it intersects the East line of Grammers  
parrel then with the said line to a bounded Oak Standing near  
M<sup>r</sup>. Towgoods Gate and in the line of Grammers parrel and from  
the said Oak Standing at the head of a little branch about 12 or 14 p<sup>d</sup>  
distance & from that Oak at the head of the said w<sup>ch</sup>. abright  
line to the first bounded Hickory containing about thirty or more  
Acre to have & to hold y<sup>e</sup>. said Quantity of Land being part  
of Grammers Parrel w<sup>th</sup> all houses timber trees profits commodities  
therunto belonging and the said Abraham Means for himself
