In primis I bequeath my soul to God who gave it me in sure  
and certaine hopes that through his Mercys and the Meritts of  
his only begotten Son my Blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ  
the same with my Body (which I will to be decently Interred at  
the discretion of my Executors hereafter named) shall be  
raised at the Last Day to Eternal Joy and Felicity.

And as touching Such Worldly Estate as it hath pleased  
 Almighty God to bless me withall, I will bequeath and dispose  
 of the Same as hereafter followeth. I give and  
 bequeath unto my Son Benjamin his heirs and Assigns for  
 ever one half part of the plantation whercon I now dwell  
 being part of a Tract of Land called the Obligation, And I  
 give and bequeath unto my Youngest Son Lewis his heirs and  
 Assigns for ever the other half part of my aforesd. dwelling  
 plantation - And my will is that the Same be as equally  
 divided betwixt them with regard to Quantity & quality  
 as may be.

And as touching my personall Estate of what kind or  
 Nature soever it be and wheresoever it be after my funeral  
 Charges are defrayed and all my Just debts paid, I will and  
 dispose of the Same as followeth - I Give unto my Son Thomas  
 Stockett the Sum of five Shillings Current Money to be pd. by my  
 Executrix hereafter named within twelve Months after my decease.  
 I Give unto my Daughter Eleanor Williams the wife of Rich<sup>d</sup>.  
 Williams a Silver Tankard and four Silver Spoons which were  
 her Mothers.

I give and bequeath unto my Son Benjamin his heirs and Assigns  
 for ever one Negroe boy Called Sivas.

I also give and bequeath unto my Son Lewis his heirs and Assigns  
 for ever one Negroe Girl called Jenny and her Increase

All the rest of my Estate I will to be divided betwixt my Loving  
 Wife Damaris & her Daughters, Viz<sup>t</sup>. One third part to my wife and  
 the other two third parts to her daughters which are now unmarried  
 Share and Share alike

Lastly I make ordaine and Constitute my dear and Loving  
 wife Damaris the full and sole Executrix of this my Last will and  
 Testament And In Witness thereof I have hereunto Subscribed my  
 Name and Affixed my Seal this thirteenth day of October Anno Dom<sup>i</sup>
