 my said son Thomas Paganary shall be without share when his said
 bequeath my said Dowry Plantation to my son Nicholas Paganary and the
 heirs of his Body lawfully begotten forever when I give and bequeath to my
 son Nicholas Paganary the Plantation formerly his Dowry Plantation
 of his Uncle William Stone Townes also another tract of land lying in the
 Parish of St Pauls Quene which I purchased of Thomas of Rotherhithe the one
 other tract of land lying to the future (being the said Dowry Plantation) My said
 being the said formerly have I gave all which I have several part of
 said give and bequeath to my said son Nicholas Paganary to him and
 his heirs and assigns forever (William Adams and Agnes his Wife) when I give and
 bequeath to my said son Nicholas Paganary my said share when I give
 and bequeath to my Daughter John Paganam the Negro Slave called young
 Charles One Negro Boy called Agnes One Negro Woman called Rachel Day
 and all her Increase Legit One Boy called John which Boy I give
 and bequeath to my godson William Paganam who give to my said
 Daughter Ann Paganam One Negro Woman called Mille Stone and all her
 Increase except his said Boy which I give to my grand Daughter
 Ann Paganam who give to my said Daughter John Paganam the sume
