I hereby certify that the bearer here of a negro man who calls himself Richard Frisby proved to me by the oath of William Hackett of Queen Anns County that he is one of the children of a negro woman named Deborah who was on the 5th day of April 1806 manumitted and set free by a certain John Hackett Esq of the County aforesaid by deed of man: duly acknowledged & recorded in Lib. S.W. Nos folio 179 her freedom to commence eight years from the 1st day of January 1807 and her issue born during the term of her servitude to be free at the age of twenty one years, said Richard is about twenty three years of age dark complexion five feet five inches high and has a small scar on his right cheek and a very notable mark on his right leg occasioned by a burn and no other notable mark discovered & was raised in the County aforesaid.

Maryland, Queen Anns County Court. Whereas application has been made to me by a negro woman ^{named} Julian Hemsey for a certificate of her freedom, I do therefore hereby certify that the said Julian together with her mother on the first day of May 1818 obtained a judgment in Queen Anns County Court against a certain George Wallis for her freedom as it appears by the records of said Court, and I for this certify that the said Julian proved to my satisfaction that she is the same person of that name who obtained judgment for her freedom as aforesaid, she is about twenty two years of age light complexion, five feet and three fourths of an inch high and has no particular mark or scar that I have discovered & was raised in the County aforesaid.
