Nos folio 179 her freedom to commence eight years from the 1st day of January 1807 and her issue born during the term of her servitude to be free at the age of twenty one years, said Richard is about twenty three years of age dark complexion five feet five inches high and has a small scar on his right cheek and a very notable mark on his right leg occasioned by a burn and no other notable mark discovered & was raised in the County aforesaid.
