Whereas application has been made to me by a negro girl who calls herself Priscy Hemslay for a Certificate of her freedom, I do therefore hereby certify that the said Priscy together with her mother Henry Hemslay on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1818 obtained judgment of freedom against a certain George Wall in Queen Anne's County Court, as it appears by the records of said Court, and I further certify that the said Priscy proved to my satisfaction that she is the same person of that name who obtained judgment of freedom aforesaid, she is about twenty one years of age light complexion, five feet high and has a small scar on her forehead and a scar on her right ankle occasioned by a burn and no other notable mark discovered and was born & raised in the County aforesaid -

I hereby certify that Henry Gibbs the bearer hereof proved to me by the oath of Edward Cottage Esquire of Queen Anne's County that he was free born and raised in Queen Anne's County aforesaid, he is about twenty one years of age black complexion five feet eight inches high, he has a small scar on the end of his left little finger, and the end of his left fore finger has been injured
