Twilley

Negro Woman, Harriett (son Callaghan's Harriett Whales) aged about thirty three years, five feet two & one half inches high, of a dark Chestnut complexion, with a Scar on the left side of her chin, and another scar ~~below~~ behind her left ear, was born and raised in Dorchester County and is the same negro girl who was manumitted by Robert R. Spedden Esq on the 9th day of September 1837. Identified by William Rea

31st

Carlisle Henry negro woman, aged about twenty one years of age five feet three & one half inches high of a light Chestnut complexion, with a scar on each leg just above the knee occasioned by a Burn, small flesh mole under her left eye, was born free and raised in Dorchester County. Identified by John D. Farguharson

Negro Woman Ann Wheatley aged about forty years, five feet & one inch high, of a Chestnut complexion, several small scars on her right arm between her elbow and hand, was born and raised in Dorchester County, and is the daughter of Diana who was manumitted by Joseph Eccleton on the 25th day of March 1802, by which said manumission the said Diana and her issue, born during the term of service of said Diana were to be free when they arrived to the age of ~~that~~ thirty one years. — Identified by C. Skinner Hubbard (blind man) the said Ann Wheatley negro is now more than 31 years of age, as proved by said Hubbard.

Susan Wheatley negro woman, aged about thirty years, five feet five & one quarter inches high, of a Chestnut complexion, has a small scar on her forehead, was born free (and raised in Dorchester County) Identified by C. Skinner Hubbard, (blind man) Samuel Abbott

Daniel Wheatley negro man, aged about twenty seven years, five feet four and a quarter inches high, of a light Chestnut complexion, has a Scar on his left arm, on the upper part of his elbow joint, was born free and raised in Dorchester County. Identified by C. Skinner Hubbard, (blind man) Samuel Abbott
