Be it remembered that on this Twenty-eighth day of January in the year Eighteen Hundred and Ninety, the following instrument purporting was received to be recorded, and is accordingly enrolled as follows, To-wit:

State of Maryland, Talbot County, et c;

I. Certify, that on this fourteenth day of January in the year eighteen hundred and ninety I have surveyed and laid out for William Kilmon, Thomas H. Kilmon and Gustavus Kilmon a tract or parcel of Oyster Ground in the waters of a branch of Edges Creek of said county adjoining the farm or plantation now occupied by Jeremiah V. Harris and described as follows, Beginning at a stake set in the water nearly at the western end of said piece of oyster ground, and opposite to the water fence close to the garden of said Jeremiah V. Harris, and running thence north 56 1/2° West 15 7/10 perches, to or about low water mark, then nearly with low water mark North 66 1/2° East, 23 7/10 perches; South 65° East, 14 3/10, North 74° East, 17 7/10 perches, to water fence between the cleared land and woodland shores of the said farm of Jeremiah V. Harris then <sup>and</sup> into the water of the creek or cove South 20 1/4° East 5 3/10 perches to a stake, then South 76 1/4° West 17 7/10 perches to another stake, the line being also marked by another stake between the last two named, then North 83 1/2° West 18 7/10 to a stake, this line being also marked by a stake set near the middle of the line, then South 70 1/2° West 14 perches to the beginning, containing One Acre, three Rods and sixteen square Perches of ground.
