KNOW all men by these presents that I Levin Greene of
Dorchester County for divers good causes and considerations
me therein moving do hereby declare free manumit and
enfranchise the Negroes following ~~Wife~~ Isaac to be and
shall be absolutely free on the first day of January eight
teen hundred and nine & Mary to be free on the first day of
January eighteen hundred and nine. Moll to be free on
the first day of January Eighteen hundred and nine. Jacob
to be free on the first day of January Eighteen hundred
and ten Joshua to be free on the first day of January
Eighteen hundred and thirteen, hereby acknowledging
the said Negroes discharged from all claim of service
or right of property whatsoever from me my heirs &
executors or Administrators after the periods above mentioned
& as witness my hand and seal this the 12th day of
May Anno Domini 1802 -
