Four Dollars Reward.

RAN AWAY, a few days ago, from the subscriber, living in Annapolis, a likely *NEGRO LAD*, named **FRANK**, about 18 years of age, 5 feet high, and slim, with a narrow or long head, and appears startled when suddenly accosted; had on and took with him, a light-coloured cloth coat with large yellow metal buttons, striped calico jacket, corduroy breeches, patched at the knees, a pair of black everlasting ditto, thread stockings, castor hat, three shoes, one of which is patched at the heel, and yellow metal shoe-buckles---His legs appear inflamed by sitting over the fire in his infancy---He is sprightly and ingenious, with as much skill in deception as any of his age---When confronted his eye falls and discovers an uncommon wide space between the lid and the brow. I bought him about two years of age, from the Rev. Doctor Weems, near South-River Church---He was seen on the road to Baltimore, on Thursday last, with a bundle---has relations in Frederick and Montgomery Counties, and may probably make that way---Any person that may apprehend him and have him committed to the County Gaol, shall receive the above reward, and all reasonable charges.
