

NOTICE.

WAS committed to the prison of Washington county, D. C. on the 18th inst. as a runaway slave; a negro man by the name of James Demster alias Winder, he is 4 feet 11½ inches high, supposed to be about 25 years of age, has a large scar on the right side of his head, occasioned as he says, by being shot, also a small scar in the middle of his forehead, and one about an inch in length on his right cheek. Had on when committed, an old fur hat, striped cotton jacket, blue cassinet trousers, and cotton shirt, says he belongs to Edward Dashiell, living near Faston on the Eastern Shore of Maryland. The owner or owners of the above described negro man, if any, is requested to come and prove him, and take him away, or he will be sold for his prison fees, and other expenses as the law directs.
