

WAS COMMITTED to the Jail of Baltimore county, on the 28th day of May, 1830, by Thomas Macgill, Esq. Justice of the Peace for the city of Baltimore, as a runaway, a negro girl of a yellow complexion by the name of MARY JENKINS, but says her name is Mary Ann Nicholas, supposed to belong to Mrs. Nancy Connolly of Easton, eastern shore of Maryland. Says she is free and came from the Trap, near Easton. Said negro girl is 4 feet 10 inches high, about 15 years of age. Had on, when committed, a blue striped cotton frock, no shoes or stockings.

The owner of the above described negro girl is requested to come forward, prove property, pay charges and take her away, otherwise she will be discharged according to law.
