

WAS COMMITTED to the Jail of Baltimore County on the 6th day of December, 1830, by Henry W. Gray, Esq. a Justice of the Peace in and for the City of Baltimore, as a runaway, a negro woman who calls herself JULIA ANN GREEN—says she belongs to widow Long, Talbot County, State of Maryland. Said negro woman is about twenty-five years old, five feet three inches high, of a dark complexion—the first finger on her left hand is crooked and stiff.—Had on when committed, a dark calico frock, coarse shoes and stockings.

The owner of the above described negro woman is requested to come forward, prove property, pay charges and take her away; otherwise, she will be discharged according to law.
