

WAS COMMITTED to the Jail of of Balti-
more County, on the 16th day of May,
1831, by Thomas Sheppard, Esq. a Justice of the
Peace, in, and for the City of Baltimore, as a
runaway a negro girl, who calls herself ANN
FLOYD, says she was brought here by her
Father, from the widow Sherwood's, living in
Talbot County, Miles River Neck, E. Shore
Maryland. Said negro girl is about 17 years old,
5 feet 5 inches high, has a scar under the right
eye, and one on the right arm. Had on when
committed, a leghorn bonnett, calico frock, and
spring heel pumps.

The owner of the above described negro girl,
is requested to come forward, prove property,
pay charges, and take her away; otherwise, she
will be discharged according to Law.
