Shore, Md. Said mulatto girl is about 15 years old, five feet, 1 inch high. Had on when committed a blue striped domestic frock, red striped handkerchief and now boots.

The owner of the above described mulatto girl is requested to come forward, prove property, pay charges and take her away; otherwise she will be discharged according to law.
