He is stout made, with rough features, particularly his hands.

Had on when he absconded, a roundabout of brown or purple colored kersey, white Ozna-burg pants, a shirt of the same kind, and a tur hat with the rim turned up. The letter F is worked in the collar of his roundabout & shirt. He took away with him, a hair cap, pair of long boots, and a blue striped summer coat, besides other clothing not recollected.—He was raised in an about Easton, Talbot county, Md.
