He also has some scars under his jaws and throat, occasioned by the scrofula when a boy. He had good clothes generally, but may show now differently.

He left home on Easter Sunday, the 11th instant, to go to see his wife at Mr. Wm. Lyles's, Jr. a few miles, with full consent from my manager, as usual for several years past, and was to have returned home on Tuesday after; and since then I have not seen or heard any thing from him more than his wife says that he left her to come home on said Tuesday.

All fishermen on the Potomac and elsewhere will please to keep a good look-out, also all captains of boats or vessels; and all persons are forewarned from harboring or employing said negro.
