### COMMITTEE OF CLAIMS.

#### BY THE COMMITTEE OF CLAIMS.

Your committee report that, they have examined the proceedings and documents of George Mackubin, Treasurer for the Western Shore of Maryland, and find from an account settled to 1st Dec. 1831, by the Committee of Claims of the last General Assembly, there then remained in the Treasury, \$335,104 74, funded 3 per cent stock, \$3,143 95 in bills of credit of the emission under an act of Congress of the 18th March 1780, and \$77,177 64 cash.

That it appears to your committee by the accounts of the said Treasurer, he has received from the 1st Dec. 1831 to 1st Dec. 1832.
