Gentlemen,—In obedience to your order of the 4th inst., we have prepared and present the foregoing Exhibit of the aggregate receipts annually for the last fifteen years, for things issued from the Treasury for common, special, and reclamation, warrants to effect lands in Allegany county. In the entries here of the sums received for caution upon the return of the certificates, the names only of the acts appear, and no notice whatever has been taken of the counties wherein the lands lie, and consequently no means are to be found in the Treasury, of ascertaining how much of such receipts was paid for land in any particular county.
