

For all which payments and investments, he has presented to your Committee satisfactory vouchers and receipts.

That it appears to your Committee, there remains in the Treasury, as of 1st Dec. 1833, to the credit of the said Funds, a balance of seventeen thousand five hundred and seventy-three dollars and twenty-two cents, cash—and this sum too, they find, stands to his credit as Treasurer, in the Farmers Bank of Maryland.
