Your committee report that, they have examined the proceedings and documents of George Mackubin, Treasurer of the Western Shore of Maryland, and find from an account settled to 1st Dec. 1833, by the Committee of Claims of the last General Assembly, there then remained in the Treasury, \$3,143 95 cents in bills of credit of the emission under an act of Congress of the 18th March 1780, and \$31,830 28 cents cash.

That it appears to your Committee, by the accounts of the said Treasurer, he has received from the 1st Dec. 1833 to the 1st Dec. 1834.
