

NO. 2.

Resolved, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the State Librarian is hereby authorised and directed to prepare a new Catalogue of the books belonging to the Library, and that he superintend the printing thereof, and that the Governor and Council cause to be paid the expenses accruing thereon.

NO. 3.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the State Librarian be and he is hereby authorised and directed to make the following disposition of the two hundred and fifty copies of the Proceedings of the Convention of the Province of Maryland, for 1774,-75,-76, now in the Library—to wit:

To the several States and Territories in the Union, 2 copies each,	56
To the several County and Orphans Courts in this State, 2 copies each,	76
To such public Academies and Colleges in the State, as shall hereafter be determined on by the committee, 2 copies each, the whole not to exceed 68 copies,	68
	200

The remaining 50 copies to be retained in the Library, subject to the future disposition of the Legislature.

NO. 4.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the joint committee on the State Library, are hereby authorised and directed to contract for counter sealing the floor of the Library, and for double sashes and blinds to the windows thereof, and that the Governor and Council cause the amount of said contract to be paid, on the completion of said work, the cost of the same not to exceed, \$150.

NO. 5.

Resolved, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor and Council, be, and they are hereby authorised and requested to contract with some person or persons for the erection of a wood house of suitable dimensions, within the public circle, and on the completion thereof, to cause the wood remaining in the cellar of this building to be removed thereto—and not to permit thereafter the use of said cellar as a depository of wood.
