

reading to Africa the expeditions which have been despatched. They respectfully beg leave to refer to the accompanying document for these details which it has thus become unnecessary to enlarge upon in this report.

The whole number of emigrants during the year was forty-nine, which added to those heretofore reported, makes the total number of 366 persons, who have left this country under the direction of the State Managers. The amount drawn from the Treasury was \$13,000, the expenditure of which is shown by the account accompanying this report.

The number of manumissions reported to the Board for the year ending on the 31st December 1836, is 276, of which as usual many are to take effect at future periods.
