To the Honorable
The House of Delegates,

The Treasurer of the Western Shore, in obedience to their order of the 2nd inst submits the following Report:—

The debt which the State has incurred for the erection of Tobacco Warehouses, in the city of Baltimore, is \$78,000—viz:

Per act of 1826, ch. 252	\$15,000
Per act of 1835, ch. 359	30,000

The receipts into the Treasury from the States Tobacco Inspection in Baltimore, including the loan of \$48,000, from the year 1826, to 1 Feb 1836, inclusive, (as shewn by his Report 10th Feb. 1836, to the General Assembly of December session, 1835, to which he prays leave to refer) had amounted to

\$325,657 04

And the disbursements from the Treasury in the same time on account of the said houses and inspection, as is also shewn in detail by the said report, had amounted to

323,880 35

Leaving then in the Treasury a balance of

1,776 69
