## The National Crisis.

Serenade to Vice-President Stephens at Richmond.

On Monday night a large number of citizens of Richmond, Va., congregated in front of the Exchange Hotel in that city, with the First Regiment Band, and serenaded the Hon. Alexander H. Stephens, Vice-President of the Confederate States of America. The Dispatch has the following sketch of his speech: The distinguished gentleman was introduced to the throng by Mayor Mayo, and received with hearty cheers. In response, Mr. Stephens returned his acknowledgments for the warmth of the personal greeting, and his most profound thanks for it as the representative of the Confederate States. He spoke of the rejoicing among her Southern sisters. Her people would feel justified if they could hear it as he had. He would not speak of the States that were out, but those who were in. North Carolina was out, and did not know exactly how she got out. The fires that were blazing here, he had seen in the streets of Richmond. At Wilmington, N. C., he had counted, on one street, twenty flags of the Confederate States.
