

STATEMENT OF THE EXPENSES OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY FOR THE YEAR 1872.

Published by order of the County Commissioners for said County, in pursuance of Section 5 of Article VIII of the Code of Public General Laws, which provides that— "The County Commissioners shall make out and publish annually, in at least two newspapers published in their respective counties, if there be two, a detailed, accurate and correct statement of the expenses of their said counties, specifying therein each particular item of expense, and for what and to whom paid; and shall also deliver to the Sheriff of their respective counties as many copies of such statement as there are election districts of said county at least ten days before such general election, and the Sheriff shall within six days after the receipt of such copies, set up one of them at the place of holding elections in each election district."
