And it shall be the duty of the said commissioners to collect every contribution relative to the proposed institution, until they shall be opened by the appointment of directors.

The books shall be opened at the places before mentioned by the commissioners, or any two of them, on the 1st of October, at noon, and remain open till noon, from ten o'clock in the morning till one o'clock past meridian, on each day, and the aforesaid number of days, and shall be subscribed to; and if there shall be a balance due in any city or county, a larger number of days than are allotted to such county, the commissioners shall, in the first instance, deduct the larger number of days, but if such reduction still remains, the subscriptions down to the number allotted, then they shall, by lot, draw, to whom these subscriptions shall pertain, or to whom the shares shall belong; and it shall be the duty of the county commissioners to return, as soon as may be, a list of the subscribers, certified by them, to the commissioners for Annapolis and for Easton, but they are to retain the subscription books.

Article 2. The Farmers Bank of Maryland shall be established at the City of Annapolis, and a branch thereof shall be established at Easton, for the eastern shore; the proportion to be allotted to the branch bank shall not exceed two-fifths parts of the capital stock.

Article 3. The capital stock of this bank shall be limited to one million and a half of dollars, to consist of thirty thousand shares of fifty dollars each, one-third part thereof, or ten thousand shares, shall be reserved for the use and benefit of the state, to be subscribed in such manner as the legislature may direct; provided that the state shall not draw a dividend on a greater number of shares or amount than has actually been paid up; that the remaining twenty-thousand shares shall be subscribed for in the different counties, agreeably to the allotment herein after mentioned, by opening books in each county, under the direction of the persons named for each county, viz.
