WASHINGTON TONTINE.

Article 1. The capital of the company shall be two hundred and fifty thousand dollars...

Article 2. Every subscriber may, at the time of subscribing, or at any time before the first day of July...

Article 3. Upon the death of any person, with whose life a share or shares shall have been made commensurate...

Article 4. The affairs of the company shall be managed under the superintendence & direction of five directors...

Article 5. The directors shall have full power to sell in fee-simple...

Article 6. All money arising from the sales of lots, shall be invested in the stock of the United States...

Article 7. The dividends shall be paid at the office of the company in Washington...

Article 8. In cases where the dividends are not claimed for six months after the same shall become due...

Article 9. The shares shall be transferable, and all transfers shall be made on the books of the company...

Article 10. Every record of a transfer of shares, and every certificate issued for shares, shall designate the lives on which such shares depend.

Article 11. No change can be made of the person or persons on whose life or lives the shares shall depend.

Article 12. The directors shall cause proper books to be kept of all their proceedings...
