for us all the probabilities are in favour of suc-  
cess.  
These sentiments are so conformable to the  
character of our nation, that it requires no ef-  
fort to make them known; but should it be  
useful to propagate them, who more than you,  
Tribunes, would hasten to employ all their in-  
fluence, to enlighten the people on their inter-  
ests, and duties? who more than you has the  
right to excite their zeal, fidelity and gratitude  
towards our august Emperor?  
The President made the following reply:  
*Gentlemen, Orators of the Council of State.*  
I sincerely believe that whilst we  
were fighting for the independence of the seas,

peror of Austria and Russia should wish to  
make a diversion in favor of the common en-  
emy, and to attack the faith of treaties,

This unjustified aggression is the mel-  
ancholy result of the ancient hatred vowed against  
France by the Court of Vienna, and of the cor-  
rupting spirit of that of Saint James.  
Need I say that that must produce the effect  
of dividing our forces; and of suspending for a  
time the vast projects which the genius of the  
Great Napoleon was at length going to execute  
against the British Government.  
But the signal faculty of the Court of Vien-  
na will shortly receive its just punishment, and  
the monarch whom France could have twice  
despoiled of more than half of his hereditary  
states, will not be long before he repents having  
renewed the continental war, actuated by mo-  
tives foreign to the true interests of the Ger-  
man Empire, and in contempt of the solemn treat-  
ies which had re-established peace on the Con-  
tinent.

all its influence to preserve them full and en-

feel no difficulty in exposing his motives;  
but the French people, will see in those

security and independence.  
Those documents prove to demon-  
stration, the great point which we are about  
to discuss.  
The unfounded complaints of Austria  
and Russia, originate from a much more  
important source than the changes which  
have been produced in Italy. From the  
commencement of the present war, those  
two powers appear to have taken an in-  
terest in the war, not for the purpose of  
mediating, but of associating themselves  
with England. Nothing but the exces-  
sive moderation of the Emperor Napo-  
leon, could have submitted to such open  
provocation.  
A glance at the map of Europe will be  
sufficient to satisfy any one, that the situ-  
ation of the European powers, relative to  
each other, has experienced considerable  
changes, since the peace of Lunville,  
more particularly since the violation of  
the treaty of Amiens. During a war  
which France was forced into, for the  
common good of Europe, Austria and  
Russia, have (availing themselves of the  
occasion) continued to augment and ex-  
tend their influence, while France in this  
respect has carried her spirit of modera-  
tion to excess. The French people might  
have cause to complain of the confidence  
reposed in Austria and Russia, by the  
Emperor Napoleon, if they were not just-  
ified in relying on his courage to avenge  
this unwarrantable abuse of his generous mo-  
deration.  
At the time when the treaty of Amiens  
was broken, the Emperor of Russia, was  
very far from assuming the influence,  
which he now exercises with such in-  
superable superiority, over the deliberations  
of the European powers. He did not stand up
