Congress. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Monday, April 7. SPANISH AFFAIRS. Debate on the motion of Mr. J. Randolph to publish the President's message.

Mr. DANA said he was happy they were enabled to take a direct vote on the publication of the message. On the vote just taken he had felt himself bound to consult the opinions of gentlemen who had thought when the injunction of secrecy was taken off...

Whenever confidential communications are received from the President of the U. S. the House shall be cleared of all persons except the members and the clerk, and so continue during the reading of such communications...

Mr. SLOAN. I shall as decidedly as the gentleman from Connecticut vote against the publication of the message; and on a principle which it behoves me never to abandon so long as I hold a seat on this floor...

Mr. J. RANDOLPH. Before the question is taken I have a few observations to offer in addition to those which I submitted the other day on the subject of the secret proceedings...
