ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION OF THE HAGERS-TOWN BANK.

WE, the subscribers, hereby associate and mutually agree, to form a Banking company, to be called and known by the name of THE HAGERS-TOWN BANK...

Article 1. The capital stock of the said Bank shall be limited to one hundred thousand dollars...

Article 2. The subscribers, to wit: Jacob Schaefer, Matthias Shadler, Merwin Kerlinger, Henry Shafe and Jacob T. Towling...

Article 3. The subscriptions shall be opened at the places before mentioned by the commissioners...

Article 4. Every subscriber shall pay to the commissioners, at the time of subscribing, the sum of five dollars...

Article 5. If any stockholder shall fail to pay up his or their installment, of five dollars on each share, on the first Monday in May next...
