The freshest Advices from Paris say, that among the new Duties imposed, they reckon the following, viz. a Penny in the Pound upon Tallow, Two Pence in the pound on Hair Powder, Two pence in the Pound on unwrought Wax, Two pence a Pound more upon white Wax, Eighteen pence a Ream upon all Writing Paper, and in Proportion upon all other Papers; upon which the Parliament bave made Remonstrances, and received from the King the following Answer: It is always with Regret that I resolve to load my People with new Impostions; but as Necessity obliges me to it, in order to obtain for them the Benefits of Peace, it is my Will and Pleasure that my Partiament proceed instantly to register the Edia, and two Dec.'arations that I have fent them. My Chancellor will explain to you what Alleviations I am inclined to make.

WILLIAMS BURG, June 9.
On Saturday last, his Majesty's Ship Hector, Capt. Masterman, arriv'd in Hampton Road, from England.
