They were clac in feal feins, wich the hair on, after the manner of their own country, their eyes and hair black, like our Indians, but their com-plexion fomewhat lighter. The Moravians, it feem, have a plexion somewhat lighter. mission also at Barbice, near Surinam, and two Ind an converts from thence, with these Greenlanders, met lately at Beilieuem, in this province (a settlement of the Moravians) with some of the Delaware Incians; and forme of the Monickons, convers also of the Moravians ; and tho' their native lands are so walt; ly remote, as the latitude of 5, 41, and 65 north, yet what they observed of each other's hair, ever and complexion, convine'd them that they were all of the fance take. find however no kind of fimilitude in their leveral languages.
